About the ARL Marketplace

The [ARL Marketplace](#) is an online platform dedicated to helping small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) start using the Australasian Recycling Label (ARL) on their packaging. It features a **range of free educational tools and resources** exploring the ARL and the benefits of sustainable packaging for businesses, customers and the environment.

The ARL Marketplace also hosts an **online packaging** directory where SMEs can find packaging from a range of packaging suppliers and apply the ARL. All packaging available on the ARL Marketplace has been evaluated for recyclability and is ready to label with the ARL in a few simple steps.

About the Australasian Recycling Label (ARL)

The ARL is a packaging label that helps Australians and New Zealanders to recycle right.

Who can use the ARL? The ARL is accessible to businesses through the Australian Packaging Covenant Organisation (APCO), either via the ARL Program or the ARL Marketplace.

About APCO

[APCO](#) is a not-for-profit organisation leading the development of a circular economy for packaging in Australia.

[Legislation](#) requires businesses with a turnover over \$5 million to report on their packaging and waste and be responsible for managing the environmental impacts of their packaging. There are two ways for businesses to meet these requirements, one of which is through the [Australian Packaging Covenant](#) which is administered by APCO. For more details, click [here](#).

APCO runs programs and platforms such as the [Australasian Recycling Label \(ARL\) Program](#), the [ARL Marketplace](#) and the [ANZPAC Plastics Pact](#).

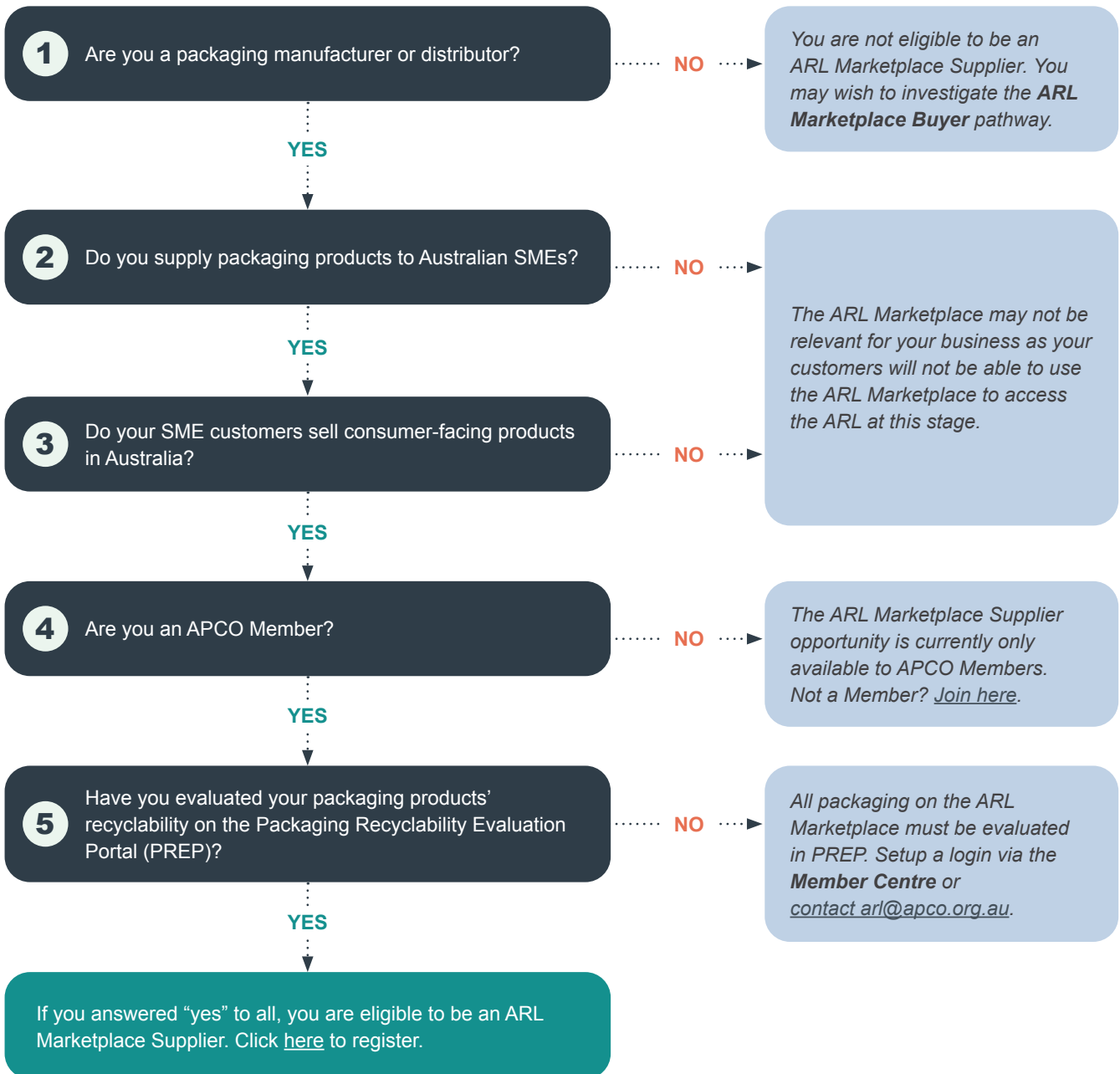
Is the ARL Marketplace right for me?

Are you a packaging manufacturer, distributor or labeller looking to support your small-to-medium sized enterprise (SME) customers to adopt the ARL?

Follow this decision tree to see if you're eligible to register as a supplier on the ARL Marketplace.

The ARL is a packaging label that helps Australians and New Zealanders to recycle right.

Is the ARL Marketplace right for me?



Joining as an ARL Marketplace supplier

Once you've confirmed the ARL Marketplace is right for you, you're only a few steps away from listing your packaging products:

- 1 **Confirm**

your APCO Membership status and your access to PREP. Unsure? Contact apco@apco.org.au
- 2 **Identify**

the products you may wish to list on the ARL Marketplace packaging directory and ensure they all have current PREP reports. Unsure? Contact arl@apco.org.au
- 3 **Nominate**

the appropriate person in your organisation to manage your ARL Marketplace listing (Note: this should be someone with authority to agree to T&Cs).
- 4 **Register**

and set up the ARL Marketplace account.
- 5 **Read**

the user guide.
- 6 **Download**

the CSV template and familiarise yourself with the information you will need to provide.

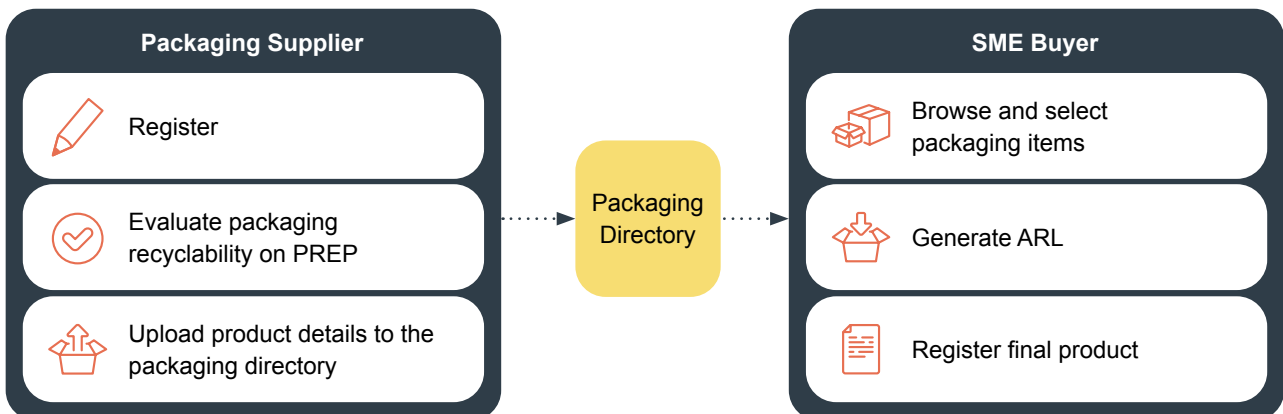
Tip: Work within your organisation to establish the best process to complete this step. If you identify any gaps or have any questions - contact arlmktplace@apco.org.au for support.
- 7 **Upload**

your CSV file and follow on-screen instructions. You will see an on-screen message once the listing is live.
- 8 **Get involved**

by sharing the promotional pack with your sales and marketing teams, so they can notify customers that your products are listed on the ARL Marketplace and ready for ARL application.

How does the ARL Marketplace work?

The ARL Marketplace has been designed to make applying the ARL on-pack a quick and simple process - for suppliers and SME buyers.

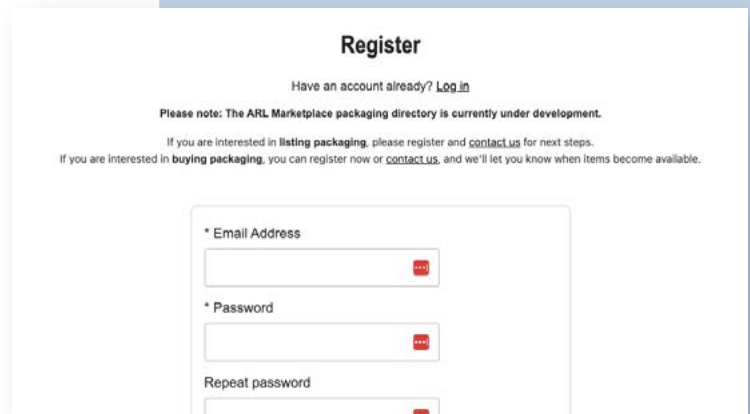


What information do I need to provide?

You can register for the ARL Marketplace as a Supplier [here](#).

Make sure you have prepared these details to register:

- **Your e-mail address** – use your company email address.
- **Create a password** – make sure it is at least 8 characters long and includes lower case, upper case, numbers and special characters.
- **Are you based in Australia?** – please select Yes or No.
- **Select Interested in:** Listing packaging.
- Your **first name** and **last name**.
- Your **company's ABN**.
- Your **company's name**. Note: use the official name associated with the ABN rather than your trading name.
- Your **position** in the company.
- **Please select:** Are you a packaging manufacturer or distributor
- Your **APCO Membership status**. Please select Yes or No. If you are unsure, contact APCO.
- Your company **website URL**.
- Your company **email address**.
- Your company **phone number**.
- Your company **logo**.
- Your **APCO Primary Industry Sector** – you should select *Packaging Manufacturers and Suppliers*.



These details will be publicly visible in your listing and used by SME customers to contact you for product details and purchase enquiries.

Important: You will be required to [read](#) and agree to the **ARL Marketplace Terms and Conditions**. Please note, the T&Cs are a legally binding contract between your organisation and APCO. Make sure you are authorised by your organisation to agree. If you are unsure, please follow your organisation's protocol.

How to navigate the website

Use the top navigation bar to switch between screens:

- **Dashboard** displays a filtered view of your listed items and enables you to archive any items you wish to remove from the listing.
- **My Products** drop-down menu takes you to **Create Listing**, where you can download a CSV template and upload your completed product listing. You can also **Export Listing** to download your current listing file, for your records.
- **My Account** enables you to manage your account details.
- **Log out**.

How to manage your account details

Access *My Account* page via the navigation. Here you can:

- **Reset password** by clicking on the hyperlink to request a new password.
- **Update your company contact details:** email address, phone number, website URL or logo.

Note: Contact arlmartplace@apco.org.au if you need to make any changes to your registration details.



Listing your products on the packaging directory

1. Create a listing:

- a. Go to *My Products* tab and select *Create Listing*.
- b. **Download the CSV template.** Start by getting familiar with the template. Refer to the ARL Marketplace Supplier CSV Explainer (Appendix A) to understand how to correctly complete the listing. Contact arlmarketplace@apco.org.au if you have any questions. **Talk to your teams** about how best to gather this information and ensure that the formatting and content is correct.
- c. **Upload your completed products file** – use the dialog box to select and upload the CSV file. If there are any issues with the file, you will receive instructions on screen.

2. Manage your listing:

- a. Go to *Dashboard* and view your listed products.
- b. **Use the search filters**, when looking for item names, product types, materials, and item status.
- c. **Archive** any products you no longer wish to list, and easily unarchive them when you need to.
- d. **Check if the products have been properly synced** from your CSV file. If an error message appears you will need to re-upload the listing.

3. Export your product listing:

- a. Go to *My Products* tab and select *Export Listing*.
- b. **View** the most recent uploaded file name.
- c. **Click Export** to download this file for your records.
- d. **Use the downloaded file** to adjust any of the product listings and re-upload on the *Create Listing* page.

Tip: When you export your listing spreadsheet you will be able to view the ARL Marketplace code, which you can provide to your customers for easy access on the packaging directory.

Tip: As a registered ARL Marketplace supplier, you have the option of creating a Secondary Material Only (SMO) Project in PREP, to evaluate secondary materials (such as labels, caps and tags) for recyclability. This will allow you to list such items as individual products on the packaging directory and for SMEs to add secondary materials to main packaging items, and create packaging projects with their correlating ARL logos. How do SMEs use the ARL Marketplace?

The ARL Marketplace features a **range of free educational tools and resources** for SMEs to learn about the ARL and the benefits of sustainable packaging for businesses, customers and the environment.

The ARL Marketplace has an **online packaging directory** where SMEs can find packaging from a range of packaging suppliers and apply the ARL. All packaging available on the ARL Marketplace has been evaluated for recyclability and is ready to label with the ARL in a few simple steps.

When an SME visits the ARL Marketplace packaging directory, they:

- **browse** the ARL Marketplace packaging directory to search for packaging items,
- **contact** the supplier for more details and to complete the purchase,
- **complete** packaging selection,
- **get** the ARL logo and,
- **register** products that carry the ARL on-pack.

Our role as an ARL Marketplace supplier

As a packaging supplier, we can help small businesses purchase our packaging and access the ARL.

For our existing customer base:

We want to encourage our existing SME customers to adopt the ARL. The ARL Marketplace is the simplest way for them to start using it. To help them along, we will:

- **Share** the news on [insert date] to let our customers know a range of our products are now listed on the ARL Marketplace and SMEs can apply the ARL on those packaging items.

- **direct** the SME customer back to the ARL Marketplace website to access the ARL logo(s).

Who is considered an SME?

Businesses with an annual turnover of less than \$50 million are considered SMEs and can access the ARL via the ARL Marketplace platform. Businesses with a larger annual turnover can access the ARL Program.

Do our SME customers need to pay?

Access to the ARL Marketplace is available to an SME if they are an APCO Member. APCO Membership fees are annual and can be found [here for Australian businesses](#) and [here for international businesses](#) selling into Australia. ARL Marketplace access is included in the membership and does not cost extra.

SMEs with an annual revenue of under \$5 million who are not APCO Members and who wish to apply the ARL on pack, can either join APCO as a Brand Owner Member, or alternatively pay an annual fee of AU\$495 (exclusive of GST). This includes unlimited access to the packaging directory, Packaging Projects and ARL previews. They will also be entitled to up to one-hour technical support and an ARL logo package.

Frequently Asked Questions – ARL Marketplace Supplier

Do I need to be an APCO Member to list my products on the ARL Marketplace?

To list your packaging items in the packaging directory, you will need to hold a current APCO Membership. Learn more [about APCO Membership types](#).

Do I need to pay a fee to register my products on the ARL Marketplace? What is the cost?

Access to the ARL Marketplace is included in your APCO Membership fees. APCO Membership fees are annual and can be found [here for Australian businesses](#) and [here for international businesses](#) selling into Australia.

What is PREP and why do I need to use it?

[The Packaging Recyclability Evaluation Portal \(PREP\)](#) is an online tool that guides brand owners and packaging designers to help determine whether a packaging component is recyclable if disposed at kerbside. Uniquely, it provides feedback to the PREP user to explain why a component is not recyclable, which potentially allows for design changes prior to market release. PREP simulates the recycling ecosystem and has the capability to evaluate the technical recyclability of a package considering its weight, shape, size, inks and glues. It then maps it against the population percentage that has access for that item to be recycled via the council kerbside recycling service, using the data from [RecyclingNearYou.com.au](#) which gets updated annually.

If your packaging item has previously been evaluated through PREP, you may be able to list it directly. In some cases, you'll need provide some more information via the CSV template.

Why do I need to use a template?

A uniform data structure is used for all ARL Marketplace listings. The template will ensure that your products are listed correctly and with the appropriate ARL logo.

How do I add or remove listed items?

You will be able to use the same file upload process to update your listing.

How do I know my data is secure?

The ARL Marketplace data transfer and storage is encrypted and compliant with industry standards. Only the information your organisation shares on the packaging directory is publicly available, and you can edit that at any time. If you have any specific questions or concerns, please contact arlmarketplace@apco.org.au.

How long does it take to list my products?

Once you upload your CSV file, you will receive an on-screen notification confirming your listing has been added to the packaging directory.

How much will my customers have to pay?

Access to the ARL Marketplace is available at no additional cost to an SME, if they are an APCO Member. APCO Membership fees are annual and can be found [here for Australian businesses](#) and [here for international businesses](#) selling into Australia.

SMEs with an annual revenue of under \$5 million who are not APCO Members and who wish to apply the ARL on pack, can either join APCO as a Brand Owner Member, or alternatively pay an annual fee of AU\$495 (+ GST). This includes unlimited access to the packaging directory, Packaging Projects and ARL previews. They will also be entitled to up to one-hour technical support and an ARL logo package.

What support will I receive?

Appendix B - Creating a Secondary Material Only Project on PREP

1. What is a Secondary Material Only project?

A Secondary Material Only (SMO) Project provides an opportunity to evaluate secondary materials (such as labels, caps and tags) for recyclability in PREP.

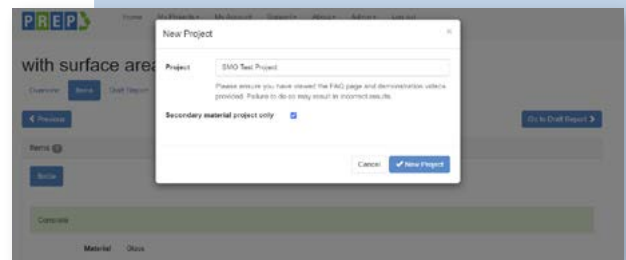
As a registered ARL Marketplace Supplier you have the option of creating an SMO project, to allow you to list such items as individual products on the ARL Marketplace Directory.

This will enable SMEs to add secondary materials to main packaging items, and create packaging projects with their correlating ARL logos.

Please note, this process is not applicable to the standard ARL Program and is only to be used to list products on the ARL Marketplace.

2. Creating a new SMO Project

When starting a New Project, activate the “Secondary material project only” tick box in the pop-up window, as shown here:



3. Entering project details

Enter the details for:

- Project Name (e.g., ABC Label X)
- Description (e.g., Bottle label)

Note: The Project-level Description refers to the overall project (e.g. Laminated bottle label), whereas the Description in the section below is for the Secondary Material element. There could be multiple Secondary Material elements for a SMO, and each can have a Description (e.g., Paper backing and LPDE sealing layer).

- Reference (e.g., 23456789B)
- Product Category (e.g., Beverage)
- Markets into which the product will be sold (tick box).

Provide secondary material details:

- Description (e.g., Label)
- Secondary Material (select from drop-down menu)
 - Other: PFAS, Other Material
 - Plastic: PET, HDPE, PVC, PVDC, LDPE, PP PS, EPS, PLA, Silicone, Biopolymer, Water dissolvable bioplastic, EVOH, Other Plastic

 - Paper: Paper, Cardboard, Glassine, Wet Strength Paper, Waxed Paper, Gable Top Carton, Aseptic LPB (Foil lined)

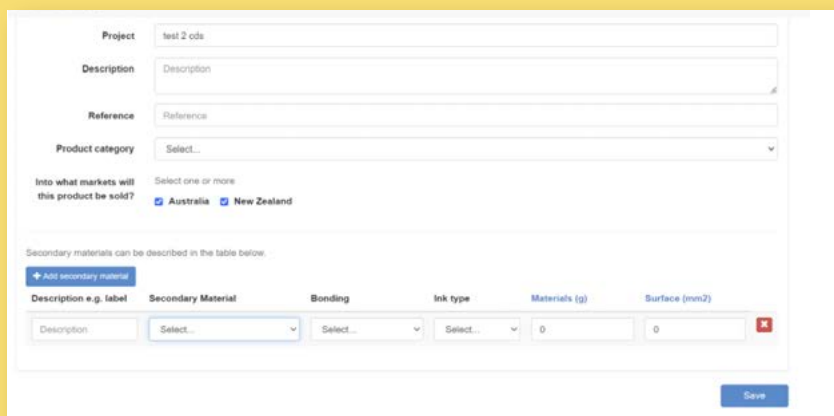

Notes:

1. You can add multiple Secondary Materials by clicking on the blue “+ Secondary Material” button. This would apply, for instance, when a paper label has a plastic laminate attached.
2. You can access more information on Materials (g) and Surface (mm²) by clicking the “i” symbols:

Weight (g) - For projects with only Secondary Materials, PREP needs to know the weight (g) of each Secondary Material. Once it is combined with a Primary Material in the ARL Marketplace, the % Weight of each Secondary Material will be calculated.

Surface (mm²) - For projects with only Secondary Materials, PREP needs to know the Surface Area (mm²) of each Secondary Material (assuming it is a 2D label/sticker). Once it is combined with a Primary Material in the ARL Marketplace, the % Surface of each Secondary Material will be calculated.
