The Australasian Recycling Label (ARL)



What is the ARL?

- · A packaging label that helps your customers to recycle right.
- It explains if packaging belongs in the waste bin, the kerbside recycling, or can be recycled by following a simple instruction.
- It shows how to dispose of all parts of the packaging.




What do the different parts of the label mean?
